ENSEMBLE HISTORY

The Tucson Music Teachers Association's Piano Ensemble has been an annual event since 1953.

TMTA members Winifred Knight and Janice McCurnin organized the first ensemble concert with Dr. James R. Anthony, University of Arizona Professor of Music History and Piano Instruction, as the conductor. Dr. Anthony continued to serve as conductor for forty years. He retired after the Ensemble's 40th anniversary concert in 1993.

Subsequent conductors have been Dr. Joan Ashcraft (1994-2003), Dr. Michael Ard (2004), and Dr. Timothy Kolosick from 2005 to the present.

The first concert in 1953 had an enrollment of fifty-six students from eight teachers. Compare this with the hundreds of students and scores of teachers in recent decades.

Other groups involved with concerts have included the Amphitheater Concert Choir, Tucson Junior Strings, Children of Baboquivari, Sahuaro Singers, and the Tucson Ballet Company. Various composers have been commissioned to write music, and arrangements and compositions by local composers and teachers have been used.

TMTA teachers give immeasurable amounts of time in planning and organizing the Ensemble concerts; however, even the best rehearsed plans go awry! At one memorable concert, student performers entered and took their places. Dr. Anthony raised his baton. The music began with two different groups performing separate pieces on stage!

TMTA continues to provide piano students the opportunity to perform within an ensemble and respond visually to a conductor. Students are gratified and proud of playing a part in the successful production of a memorable, formal performance which showcases their talents and many hours of hard work.



J. Timothy Kolosick, Ph.D., is Professor Emeritus at the University of Arizona School of Music. He has been a specialist in applications of high technology to music analysis, performance, and instruction. He is the author of numerous articles, books, and award-winning music computer software and is a recipient of the Five-Star Teaching Award at the University of Arizona. Dr. Kolosick is a former director of the Peter Treistman Fine Arts Center for New Media, the research arm of the College of Fine Arts. His work with keyboard ensembles began in 1992 with a grant that founded Orchestra Nova, a live keyboard orchestra. He is past conductor of the Yamaha-sponsored Clavinova Festival. He holds degrees from the University of the Pacific, Conservatory of Vienna, University of London, and University of Wisconsin-Madison. He was the Assistant Conductor at the Vienna Conservatory and a member of the conducting staff of the Wisconsin Youth Symphony Orchestras. A Fulbright Professor Exchange took him back to London to teach music theory and conducting at Goldsmiths College. His conducting professors include Kyung Soo Won, Gustav Koslik, and Catherine Comet. 




