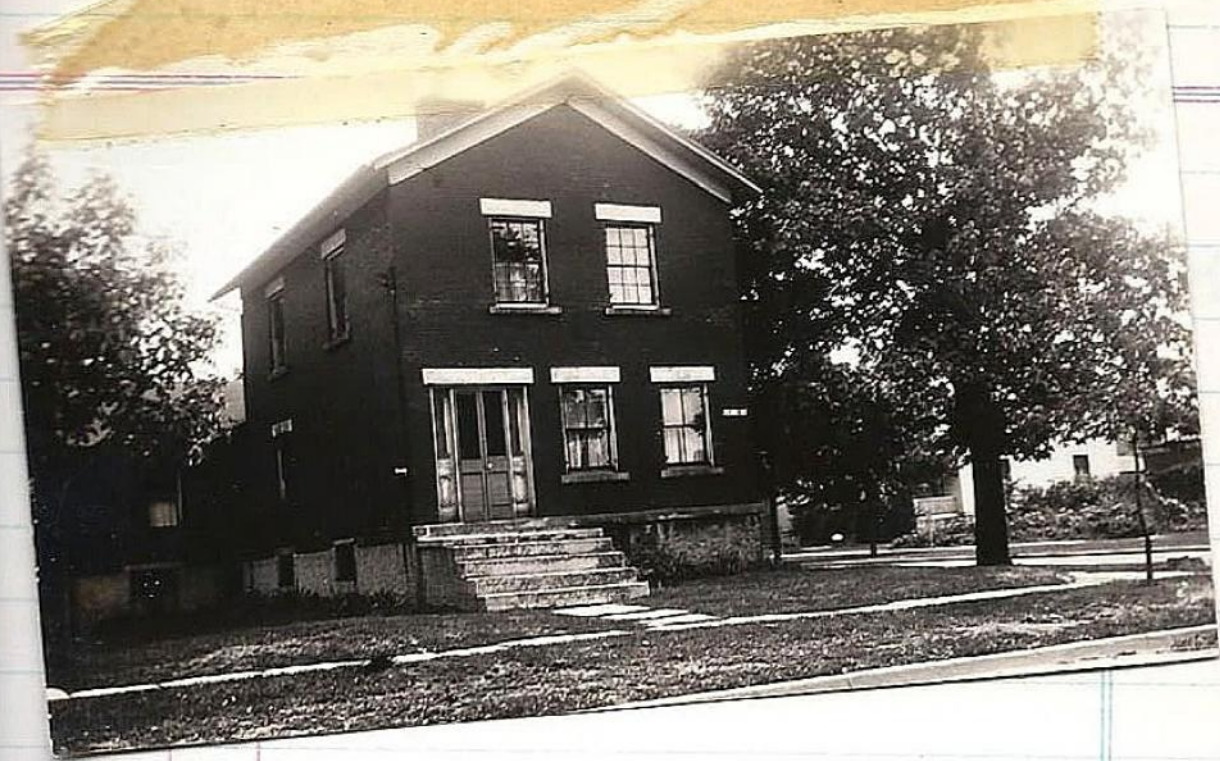

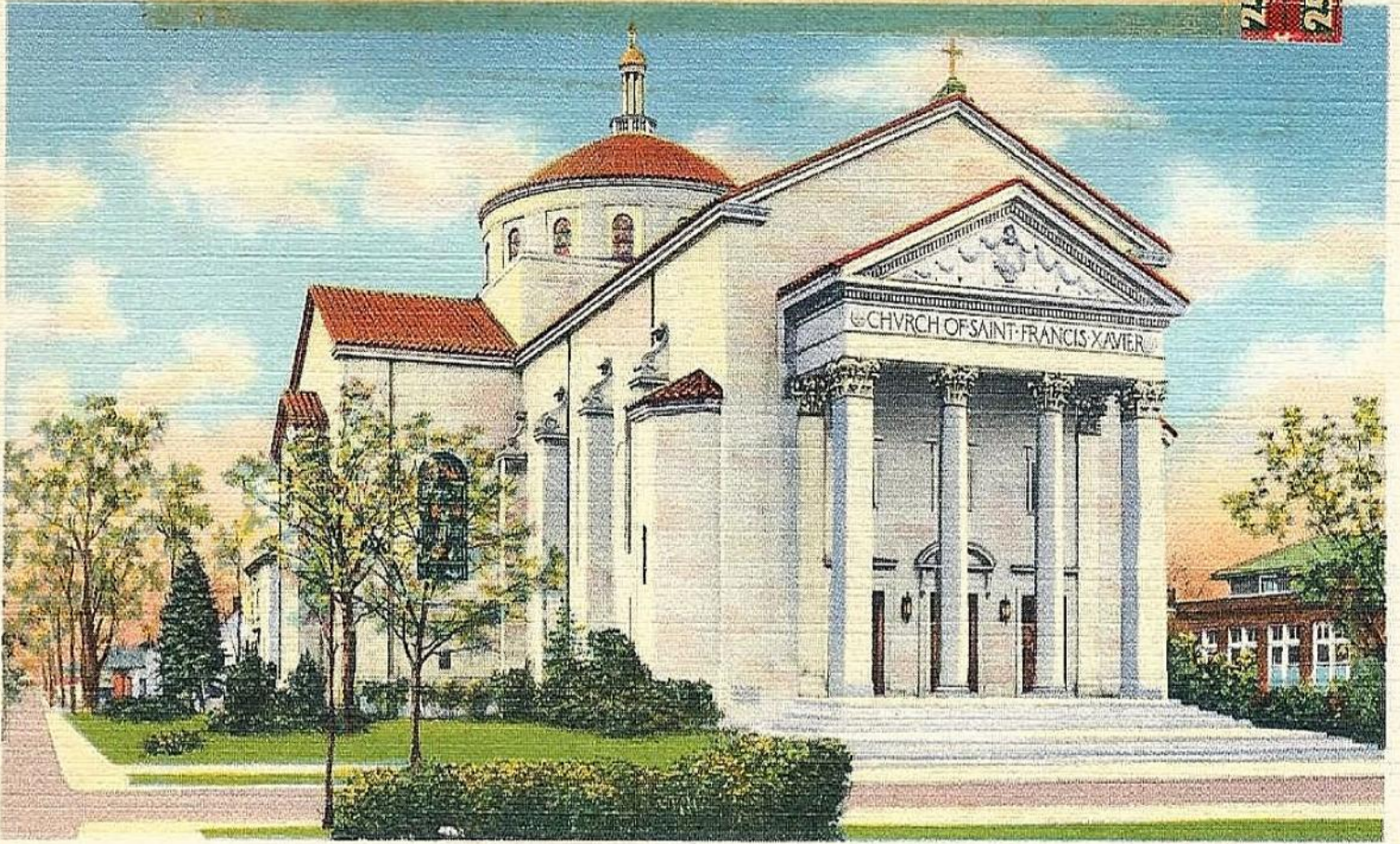
Birth place of Dad's mother - Caroline Louise

for the funeral.

Funeral mass at St. Philomenas
at 11 - Father A'Hearn delivered a
very practical sermon.

son George + Loretta - also near
Aunt Martha Homegardner's grave
R.C.P. Jan 12 - 1946

Reception for new pastor Rev.
John Henry Nawn at church
and auditorium - Wed 5th - 19

Joseph + Nell and baby John
Paul moved to my house
19 Richmond Ave - on May 1st
- 1942 -

They came up from Springfield +
stayed at Sheehans until
house on Richmond was vacant.
