And now at this time this cause coming for  
final hearing and the defendants being severally  
called three times came not to answer but  
made default ~~And~~ therefore ordered by  
the Court that the said Complainants bill and  
the matters and things therein alleged and set  
forth be taken as confessed And that the Court  
being sufficiently advised of and concerning  
the the premises it ordered by the Court that said  
Administratrix sell the Lands in her said Bill men-  
tioned and described - On such credit and  
under such restrictions as are provided by  
Statute in such case - To wit sixty acres off of  
the north side of the South East quarter of section  
six in Township No nine north of Range No one  
West - [And <sup>five</sup> acres part of the West half of  
the north east quarter of section Twelve in Township  
No 9 north of Range No two West - Commencing  
in the West line of said quarter section thirty rods  
south of the North West Corner of said quarter  
thence thence East 80 Rods to the East side  
of said half quarter thence South ten rods  
thence West 80 rods to the West line of said  
quarter thence North ten rods to the place of  
beginning -] And it is further ordered that  
the said Administratrix make report of her  
actings and doings to this Court

And now comes Fousia Hatch  
Administratrix of the estate of Jonathan Hatch  
deceased and begs leave to report that

On the fifth day of May A.D. 1838 she  
did sell the Lands described in her Petition  
filed herein in this Court to wit "Sixty acres  
N. Side S. E. quarter of section six Township nine  
North of Range one West of the 4th Principal  
Meridian - and five acres part of the West  
half of the N. E. quarter of section twelve in  
Township nine North range two West

Which said sale was made at the Court House  
door in the Town of Vermont on a credit  
of nine Months after giving due  
notice according to Law

And which said sixty acre lot as above  
described was struck off and sold to Wm  
F. George for the sum of one hundred and  
twenty one <sup>dollars</sup> The same being the highest and  
best bid for the said sixty acre lot

And the said five acres being struck  
off and sold to Rufus Thorne for the sum  
of fourteen dollars the same being the  
highest and best bid for the said 5 acre  
lot as above described

And that she the said Administratrix  
now has the money in Court

All of which is respectfully reported

And the said Administratrix further reports  
that she has made and executed deeds of  
conveyance to the purchasers aforesaid
